



Pastor Dr. Marcus D. Davidson Musical Biography

An extraordinary power of anointing with a mixture of worship is just one way to describe the ministry of a young man with purpose and vision, Pastor Marcus D. Davidson. Reverend Davidson, a well-known established Pastor has traveled the world spreading the good news of Jesus Christ through the preached word at churches, national and state conventions, workshops, seminars, and revivals. With the release of his debut album "*I'll Say Yes*" he continues to convey the message in song.

A native of Tuscumbia, Alabama, Pastor Davidson accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at the early age of six and he answered the voice of Jesus at the youthful age of sixteen to preach the gospel. Pastor Davidson is a graduate of Deshler High School, Tuscumbia, Alabama. In furthering his studies, he received a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering Technology from Alabama Agricultural and Mechanical University, Normal, Alabama, Master of Biblical Studies from Heritage Bible College, Huntsville, Alabama, Master of Divinity from Beeson Divinity School at Samford University, Birmingham, Alabama, and a Doctor of Ministry (with an emphasis in Black Church Leadership) from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. His doctoral project was "Developing Church Members into Ministry Leaders." He has also studied at Dallas Theological Seminary in Dallas, Texas and abroad at the Caribbean Graduate School of Theology, Kingston, Jamaica in the West Indies. Pastor Davidson now travels across the country ministering the gospel of Jesus Christ in both song and the preached word.

In 1999, Davidson was elected Pastor of the Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Courtland, Alabama. Currently, Pastor Davidson serves as the Senior Pastor of the New Mount Olive Baptist Church in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. He also serves as Assistant Treasurer, Budget Committee Member, and Member of Consortium of Young Pastors of the National Baptist Convention USA, Incorporated. Dr. Davidson serves as a member of the Board of Trustees for the Florida Memorial University in Miami Gardens, Florida and is an active member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated.

Pastor Marcus D. Davidson released his debut album in April 2007 which conveys a spirit-filled worship experience with a down home traditional flavor. The debut release "*I'll Say Yes*" garnered Pastor Davidson the 2007 Male Vocalist of the Year Award for the Alabama People's Choice awards for the State of Alabama. With much success, this project promises to be on the airwaves for quite some time.

Recently, in 2008, he recorded along with Rev. Clifford L. Mayes and Rev. Elliott T. Ivey, Sr., their collaboration CD release "*When Pastors Meet*". Dr. Marcus D. Davidson has been quoted in several newspaper articles in various states. Dr. Davidson calls his singing voice "a gift from

God" - and his mother. On August 23, 2010, he appeared on the Trinity Broadcasting Network (TBN) program, Praise the Lord, which is one of their most popular faith programs. Pastor Davidson continues to travel the world preaching, evangelizing, teaching, and singing to win souls for the Kingdom holding true to the fact that "to whom much is given, much is required." Dr. Davidson takes the opportunity prior to speaking, preaching, or singing to encourage and remind the audience with five memorable motivational words "How Good the Lord Is".
