PRIVACY POLICY

You have entered the PMD Ministries, Inc. website. PMD Ministries, Inc. ("PMD MI") makes it a high priority to protect your privacy and the confidentiality of the personal information you enter into its website (i.e., pastormarcusdavidson.com) or provide to us offline via guest registration cards or otherwise. PMD MI takes the following position regarding your rights to privacy and confidentiality. Please read this statement carefully and refer to it whenever necessary. If you have any questions, please contact us at pastor@pastormarcusdavidson.com.

PMD MI wants to demonstrate its commitment to your privacy. We are committed to using this website to provide information about PMD Ministries, Inc. services and programs. This Privacy Notice discloses the privacy practices for PMD MI and our website, including:

1. What personally identifiable information of yours or third party personal identification is collected from you through our website and otherwise;
2. How the information is used;
3. With whom the information is used;
4. What choices are available to you regarding collection, use and distribution of the information;
5. The kind of security procedures that are in place to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of information under PMD MI' control; and
6. How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

While the nature of our business and our website is strictly educational, financial, preaching, ministering, and singing the Gospel, and are not designed to appeal to children under the age of 13, we do believe that protecting the privacy of the very young is especially important. For that reason, we do not knowingly attempt to solicit or receive any information from children.

We are required by law to give you this privacy notice to explain how we collect, use and safeguard your nonpublic personal information. This website includes specific applications which provide a vast array of services which may enable us to respond to Biblical questions, prayer requests, or other specific questions pertaining to PMD Ministries, Inc. or other matters from website visitors.

Information We Collect and Disclose About You

PMD MI is the sole owner of the information we collect. We collect information from our customers at several different points on our website as well as through guest registration cards, product ordering, prayer requests, and various other means. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in any way that differs from what is disclosed in this notice.

We will not collect nonpublic personal information about you just because you visit this Internet site. There are applications on this website that provide you with the opportunity to inquire or order CDs, listen to samples of various sermons, inquire about an upcoming engagement, submit an invite for a musical concert or a speaking engagement; ask questions requiring a response, submit a prayer request, sign up for mailing list and electronic newsletters, participate in a customer surveys, or provide us with your email and contact information for future engagements

in your area. Using these services is voluntary and may require that you provide additional personal information to us if you anticipate making a purchase or a charitable contribution. Providing the requested information implies your consent for us to use this data in order to respond to your specific request.

We may disclose all the information we collect, as described previously, to companies that perform marketing services on our behalf or to other individuals, ministries, conventions, churches with whom we have joint marketing agreements. To protect your privacy, we only work with companies that agree to maintain strong confidentiality protections and limit the use of information we provide. We do not permit these companies to sell your information that is provided to third parties.

In order to conduct the business of our ministry, we may also disclose nonpublic information about you under other circumstances as permitted or required by law. These disclosures typically include information to process transactions on your behalf pertaining to a purchase, conduct the operations of our ministry; follow your instructions as you authorize, or protect the security of our historical and financial records.

By providing PMD MI with your contact information you expressly consent to PMD MI' use of this contact information, including to provide you with information on products and services offered or to be offered by PMD MI and its affiliates, as well as to allow select other parties with whom PMD MI conducts business ("Third-Party Providers") to provide you with information about certain products and services. If you need to update your personal information (such as email address) you may notify PMD MI via email at pastor@pastormarcusdavidson.com. If you prefer to write to us by mail, we will provide our address to you upon request via email. In the event you desire to no longer receive communications regarding product information or services from PMD MI, you may notify PMD MI via email at pastor@pastormarcusdavidson.com and request removal from product and service information mailings by PMD MI.

Except as set forth in this Privacy Statement, personally identifiable information is not otherwise released by PMD MI to outside parties unless required by law or legal process (for example, subpoena or court order). PMD MI reserves the right to make exceptions to this policy in exceptional circumstances (such as suspected illegal activity) on a case by case basis and at the sole discretion of PMD MI. PMD MI abides by applicable laws and regulations governing the disclosure of information to governmental agencies.

Ordering

Our product order forms require you to disclose personal information. Here a customer must provide contact information (such as name and shipping address) and financial information (such as credit card number and expiration date). This information is used for billing purposes and to fulfill the customers' order(s). If we experience difficulty while processing an order, the contact information is used to contact the user. Use of all PMD MI products is subject to the terms and conditions of the then current Copyright License Agreement; rules and regulation laws.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on a user's hard drive by a web browser, at the request of a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs, deliver viruses to your

computer, or extract personal information from your computer. The cookies we assign to you are unique, and can only be read by our web servers. Cookies can provide our users with a more personalized and convenient visit to our website. For instance, by setting a cookie on our site, the user may not have to reenter their username multiple times, thereby saving time while on our site. However, a user can still use our site if they reject the cookie. Cookies may also enable us to track and target the interests of our users in order to enhance the experience customers have while on our sites.

Log Files

We use Internet Protocol (“IP”) addresses to analyze trends, administer our site, track users' movement, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses of visitors to our public websites are not linked to personally identifiable information. PMD MI may, in its sole discretion, record the IP address of the computer from which an email originated as part of our ongoing effort to detect fraudulent information, spam, or viruses being transmitted via the Internet.

How We Protect Your Information

PMD MI takes strong precautions to protect our users' information. When users submit sensitive information to PMD MI via the website or otherwise, their information is protected both on-line and off-line.

Security

PMD MI restricts access to your personal information to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or program services to you. Our employees are trained in the importance of maintaining confidentiality and privacy of your information. Only employees who require the information to perform a specific job (for example, our accountant, president, or a customer support representative) are granted access to personally identifiable information. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect nonpublic personal information. Furthermore, ALL employees are kept up-to-date on our security and privacy practices. On an ongoing basis, as well as any time new policies are added, our employees are notified and/or reminded about the importance we place on privacy and what they can do to ensure our users' information is protected.

Links

Our website may contain links to other web sites. Please be aware that PMD MI is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. We encourage our users to be aware when they leave our site and to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy policy statement applies solely to information collected by the website of PMD MI and no other sites.

Newsletter

We provide users the opportunity to receive newsletters via e-mail. If a user wishes to subscribe to our newsletter, we ask for contact information such as name and e-mail address. Users who no longer wish to receive our newsletter may opt-out of receiving these communications by using the unsubscribe option in the newsletter email or by contacting PMD MI at pastor@pastormarcusdavidson.com.

Surveys

From time-to-time we request information from users via surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary and the user therefore has a choice whether or not to disclose this information. Information requested may include contact information (such as your name and shipping address), and demographic information (such as zip code, business size, etc.). Survey (demographic) information will be used for the purposes of monitoring or improving the use and satisfaction of our site, products and/or services. Our surveys may have separate rules other than those listed above. We will identify how the information supplied may be used in each such individual case.

Change of Control

In the event of a sale, merger, transfer, exchange or other disposition (whether of assets, stock or otherwise) of all or a portion of PMD MI and/or its subsidiaries, users personally identifiable information may be transferred. Users will have the opportunity to opt-out of further secondary use of information following any change of control.

Notification of Changes

If we decide to materially change our Privacy Policy, we will post those changes on the page(s) of our website where the policy is regularly located (and with an updated revision date) so that our users can always be made aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we disclose it. We will use information in accordance with the Privacy Policy under which it was collected. PMD MI encourages you to periodically review this Privacy Policy to be informed of how we are protecting your information.
